

Metal Mobile Ion Geochemistry Technical Seminar

On April 5th, 2018 from 3 pm to 5 pm in Boardroom 3 at the Valhalla Inn in Thunder Bay, you are invited to join Pierrette Prince as she leads a 2-hour technical seminar discussing the history of **Mobile Metal Ion (MMI™)** soil geochemistry, its applications in mineral exploration and the new technical developments.

With over 20 years of experience, SGS has accumulated a vast knowledge and database of case studies, technical bulletins and journal articles to provide the exploration community with examples of how the **MMI™** performs in many environments and over a large number of commodities. Several new developments with the **MMI™** technology has occurred in the last several years including **MMI™** being used as a regional mapping tool. This success has led to **MMI™** being used for archaeological purposes as well as bioavailable nutrients for agricultural purposes.

A new innovative approach to interpret large geochemical databases has also been developed by Mann, de Caritat and Sylvester (2016), first published a method for statistical comparison of two samples which allowed for objective assessment and display of the multi-element information in a form which allowed areas of similar lithology to be recognized and mapped.

About the Presenter

Pierrette has been involved with **MMI™** since its inception in 1996 into the commercial geochemistry market. Having a wide range of experience in the analytical field since 1978 Pierrette is able to draw upon her technical skills to help the advancement of geochemistry. After starting her career in the junior mining exploration field and setting up several analytical testing laboratories she joined the Ontario Geological Survey in the newly built state of the art facilities in Northern Ontario.

After gaining several years of experience with the OGS she joined SGS Minerals to work on the commercial side of the business which included marketing of the **MMI™**. For over 20 years with SGS, Pierrette has been responsible for many aspects of the geochemistry business as well as the on-site laboratory business globally. After a short retirement, Pierrette rejoined SGS to focus on **MMI™**.
